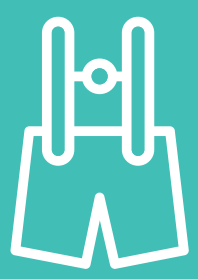

WHEN GUESTS BOOK

HOUSE RULES



Is your house manual upto date? Share it with your guests and highlight rules about parties and quiet time in your neighborhood.

TRAVEL INSTRUCTIONS



Make sure to send your guests travel instructions and don't forget to send them your last name, so they know where to buzz. You can also put a sticker on your buzzer, to make it even easier for your guests to find your home.

NEIGHBORS



Let your neighbors know that you will be welcoming Airbnb guests to your home during Oktoberfest and they can approach you with questions anytime.

WHEN GUESTS ARRIVE

KEYS



Give your guests a snap hook so they can safely attach them to their belt.

TAP WATER



Prepare a water carafe for your guests. Many guests don't know that Munich tap water is great, and it's also a good hangover cure the day after Oktoberfest.

YOUR ADDRESS



Write your address on a small piece of paper so your guests can find their way home, even if their phone battery runs low.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT



The train stop Theresienwiese gets very busy during Oktoberfest. Guests can also use one of the surrounding stops like Schwanthalerhöhe and Goetheplatz.
